Participants are responsible for their own travel arrangements to and from UC Berkeley from their home country, and for covering approximately US\$400 in additional meals and incidentals. Participants are also responsible for procuring short term medical insurance to cover the duration of the program. If you have questions or need assistance, please inquire. Each accepted applicant is responsible for seeking his/her own funding from government, employers, sponsors or other funding institutions to cover the course fees, visa, all travel expenses, and incidentals.
