The 2019 Beahrs ELP application has four scholarship review periods. Please submit your application by October 20th, 2018 to be considered for the first round of scholarship review or November 17th, 2018 for the second round of scholarship review. Those who submit their application for the final deadline of December 10th will also be reviewed for scholarship; however, we cannot guarantee that there will be any remaining funds available for those who apply after November 17th, 2018. We have a limited number of scholarships available for **domestic applicants** (USA and Canada) for those who apply before the January 25th deadline.

The final due date for the 2019 Beahrs ELP application is January 25, 2019. Please submit all application materials (application form, CV/resume, 2 letters of rec) by this due date to be considered for admission to the program. Materials submitted after this date will be reviewed but not considered for scholarship.

We strongly encourage applicants to submit their application materials as soon as possible in order to have extra time to apply for outside funding and visas.



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
